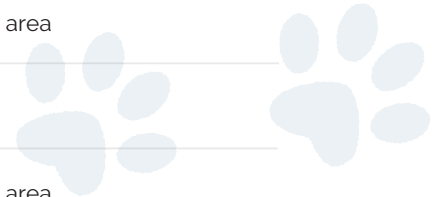


# TOOLS

## PUPPY HOUSE TRAINING EXAMPLE SCHEDULE



| Time             |   |
|------------------|---|
| 6:00 am          | Take puppy outside and praise for toiling in the desired area   |
| 6:15 am          | Feed puppy breakfast  |
| 6:45 am          | Take puppy outside and praise for toiling in the desired area   |
| 7:00 am          | Puppy spends time with you on a lead or at your feet while you have breakfast or get ready for your day       |
| 8:00 am          | Toilet break for puppy. If you are going to work, place puppy in puppy pen or secure yard area when you leave |
| 8:15 am          | Puppy play time   |
| 8:30 am          | Quiet time alone for puppy in puppy pen/secure area or crate time if crate training                           |
| 9:30 am          | Toilet break for puppy then play pen time or training time  |
| 12:00 pm         | Lunch time feed, fresh water (younger puppies may need an extra toilet break before this)                     |
| 12:30 pm         | Toilet break for puppy  |
| 1:00 pm          | Quiet time alone for puppy in puppy pen/secure area or crate time if crate training                           |
| 3:00 pm          | Toilet break for puppy  |
| 3:15 pm          | Training session, play time, quality time   |
| 5:30 pm          | Feed time, fresh water  |
| 6:00 pm          | Toilet break for puppy  |
| 10:00 - 11:00 pm | Last toilet break before bed time for puppy   |
| Younger Puppies  | One or two toilet opportunities may be required through the night   |

# PUPPY SOCIALIZATION CHECKLIST



This checklist is a guide to help you with ideas to make sure that your puppy experiences enough socialization to sounds, environments, animals and people. You should aim to tick as many boxes as possible and at least four times for each item.

Concentrate on creating a positive or neutral experience, avoiding bad experiences and not allowing your puppy to be over stimulated, i.e. very rough play with another puppy or over-excitement on greeting a new person.
